



St Mary's Primary School - Major Behaviour Matrix

MAJOR BEHAVIOUR	BRICK	DEFINITION
Inappropriate Location	B R I C K	Student leaves the school ground.
Abusive or Inappropriate Language	B R I C K	Student delivers messages that include swearing, name calling, use of words in an inappropriate way, threatening or deliberately hurting someone with words.
Excluding Others	B R I C K	The delivery of disrespectful messages in any format related to gender, ethnicity, sex, race, religion, disability, physical features.
Physical Aggression	B R I C K	Student intentionally engages in actions involving serious physical or emotional harm <i>For example: hitting, punching, hitting with an object, kicking, hair pulling, scratching, tackling, pushing, spitting, intimidation, gestures</i>
Property Damage/ Vandalism	B R I C K	Student deliberately destroys or defaces school or personal property.
Misuse of Technology	B R I C K	Student engages in serious inappropriate (as defined by school) use of mobile phone, music / video players, camera and/or computer, IPAD as outlined in 'Acceptable Use Agreement'
Theft	B R I C K	Student is in possession of having, or passed on, or being responsible for removing someone else's or school property.
Inappropriate Display of Affection	B R I C K	Student engages in inappropriate comments, gestures or physical contact, either consensual or non-consensual.

Response

1. Student to be redirected to a supervised area to fill out BRICKS reflection sheet.
2. Parents are notified by phone and a meeting scheduled.
3. Decision made by leadership what appropriate action needs to take place.
