



# St Mary's Primary School - Minor Behaviour Matrix

MINOR BEHAVIOUR	BRICK	DEFINITION
Disrespect	B R I C K	<b>Student behaves in a socially rude manner or engages in a brief or low intensity failure to follow directions.</b> For example: refusal, ignoring, didn't hear/understand the direction, talking back, putdowns, tone of voice, body language
Disruption to Learning	B R I C K	<b>Student engages in low-intensity, inappropriate disruption.</b> For example: calling out, continuing to talk, making noises eg: tapping pencil etc., being in the wrong place, preventing someone else from learning
Physical Contact	B R I C K	<b>Student engages in inappropriate physical contact.</b> For example: hands on (piggy backs, lifting children, massaging, tickling, poking, kissing / hugging, rough tackling / pushing)
Excluding Others	B R I C K	<b>Student deliberately excludes others from learning or playing.</b>
Inappropriate Language	B R I C K	<b>Student engages in low-intensity instance of inappropriate language where intent is not to threaten, insult or offend.</b>
Inappropriate Location / Out of Bounds	B R I C K	<b>Student leaves or misses class without permission.</b> <b>Student and with intent, is in an area that is inappropriate or outside of school boundaries.</b> For example: behind classrooms, inside building, front area of school, side of Church
Punctuality and Attendance	B R I C K	<b>Student arrives at class after the bell (or signal that class has started)</b>
Misuse of Technology	B R I C K	<b>Student engages in inappropriate (as defined by school) use of mobile phone, music/video players, camera and/or computer, iPad, email, chatrooms, online games (as outlined in Acceptable Use Agreement.)</b>
Property Misuse	B R I C K	<b>Student engages in low-intensity misuse of property.</b> For example: using things that don't belong to the student, using things in an unsafe way
Property Damage	B R I C K	<b>Student participates in an activity that results in destruction or disfigurement of property (school or personal).</b> Is this only needed as a major?
Uniform	B R I C K	<b>Student is out of uniform (as outlined in Uniform Policy.)</b>

## RESPONSE

- Warning** - Student is given a warning about their behaviour.
- First Minor** - Student to fill out a BRICKS reflection sheet. Take it to Principal/Delegate, and a signed copy uploaded to Seesaw. Details to be entered into Live Diaries.
- Second Minor** - Student to fill out a BRICKS reflection sheet. Take it to Principal/Delegate, and a signed copy uploaded to Seesaw. Details to be entered into Live Diaries.
